Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

John Rowling is past President and co-founder of CAMRA BC (the Campaign for Real Ale Society of British Columbia) and a co-founder and long-time director of Victoria's Great Canadian Beer Festival Society.

Rowling was born in the United Kingdom, in Sidcup, Kent in the suburbs of London on May 11, 1940. He survived the Blitz and a bomb that destroyed all the houses on his street save his family home. Rowling studied at London University, graduating with a B.Sc. in Geology in 1962. He emigrated to Canada later that year to pursue graduate studies at the University of New Brunswick (UNB) in Fredericton. After four years at UNB, Rowling settled in Calgary, working as an exploration geologist for Chevron and other companies for the next 20 years. In 1988, he moved to Victoria to take up a position in the Petroleum Geology Branch of the BC Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, continuing there until his retirement in 1997.

In 1968 Rowling married Carol Graham, and they had three children and six grandchildren. Carol passed away in 2022.

Rowling has been a beer and pub enthusiast all his life. From Canada he followed the activities of the UK's Campaign for Real Ale (CAMRA) movement. His brother Rob had joined CAMRA UK in 1974,

later becoming President of the Boston, Licolnshire branch. Shortly after his move to Victoria, John learned of the existence of a CAMRA Canada and signed up. On April 7, 1990 at a meeting at Spinnaker's Pub in Victoria, Rowling along with his wife Carol and Phil Cottrell and Dave Preston founded a CAMRA Victoria branch. The group opted for independence from the eastern-based CAMRA Canada and in September 1990 registered CAMRA BC as an incorporated society, with its own constitution, by-laws and finances. Rowling served as the first President from 1990-1992, with a further term in 2000-2003. Rowling and other CAMRA BC members participated in Victoria's first beer festival in July 1992. The experience inspired them to create an annual festival under CAMRA's auspices. Starting in 1993 as the Victoria Microbrewery Festival, it showcased BC's craft breweries, while also bringing in a smaller number of brewers from other provinces and the USA. In 1995, the event was renamed the Great Canadian Beer Festival (GCBF) and a separate body, the GCBF Society, was spun off from CAMRA to assume ongoing responsibility for planning and organization. Rowling and Gerry Hieter were for many year the main organizers, and Rowling remained a GCBF Director until 2018. In 2019 the GCBF Society disbanded and a new organization, the Victoria Beer Society, took over responsibility for the festival. Rowling was a frequent contributor to CAMRA BC's newsletter, What's Brewing, launched in June 1990 under the editorship of Phil Atkinson. (CAMRA UK, CAMRA Canada and CAMRA BC all had newsletters by this same name.) With the very first issue of What's Brewing BC, Rowling started the long-running column that would eventually become The Hopbine, "a fresh gathering of news and gossip"). In his column Rowling brought together short news items, announcements, reviews, comments and opinions on happenings in the beer world; he continued to write it until the end of 2003. From about 2004-2015, Rowling regularly wrote about beer and the BC craft beer scene for Victoria's Eat Magazine, and during the same period he was the BC correspondent for the California-based Celebrator Beer Magazine. In 2002, Matt Phillips of Victoria's Phillips Brewing Company created a special beer to honour Rowling as "a trailblazer and true champion of the craftbrewers' art" – Big Bad John's Traditional English Barley Wine. "Giants fear him / Taste buds applaud him" declared its label. In 2018 Rowling stepped down from the Board of the GCBF Society. The following year, Rowling and Gerry Hieter were presented with Legend Awards at the BC Brewing Awards, in recognition of their contributions to BC's craft beer community.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of records made or received by John Rowling in the course of his activities as a founder, organizer and member of the Campaign for Real Ale Society (CAMRA Victoria / BC) and the Great Canadian Beer Festival Society (GCBF), and as a writer on the BC craft beer scene and a collector of brewery and beer-related artefacts (breweriana).

Fonds includes paper files, born-digital records, and physical artefacts. It includes the organizational files of CAMRA Victoria / BC ([series 1](f-318-1)) and the GCBF Society ([series 2](f-318-2)); working files, drafts and articles Rowling wrote for What's Brewing Magazine, Celebrator Beer News, and Eat Magazine ([series 3](f-318-3)); personal correspondence and subject files relating to brewing and the BC craft beer ([series 4](f-318-4)); Rowling's personal collection of breweriana - beer bottles, labels, posters, glasses, t-shirts, business cards and other brewery artefacts ([series 5](f-318-5)); and his library of beer reference works, guidebooks and magazines ([series 6](f-318-6)).

Alternative form available

The fonds is a hybrid that includes paper files, analog artefacts and born-digital records. Two photo scrapbooks (binders) have been digitized as pdf files ([F-318-1-6-0-1](f-318-1-6-0-1) and [F-318-5-2-0-1](f-318-5-2-0-1)); the original binders have been dismantled and the photos re-housed in photographic enclosures for long-term preservation. Born-digital records are located in series 1 through 3. File formats include textual documents (doc, docx, pdf, txt), spreadsheets (xls, xlsx) and images (jpg, png, tif). Some access copies have been created in pdf format (see [series 2-5](f-318-2-5) and [series 3](f-318-3)). Consult the reference archivist for more information about accessing the files in their original formats.

Restrictions on access

Paper files are open for access in the Archives reading room; most digital files are open and available by offline delivery. Some digital materials are directly available online, see series [1-6, CAMRA photographs](f-316-1-6), [2-5, GCBF photographs](f-316-2-5), and [3, Beer writings](f-316-3). Files in series [1-3, CAMRA membership files](f-318-1-3), contain the personal information of individual CAMRA members; access is restricted, but files are accessible through a research agreement - consult the reference archivist for more information.

Conditions governing use

Copyright applies to the records in the fonds and copyright ownership is mixed. Rowling retains copyright in works he himself authored, and he agreed to make these available under a Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial license ([CC BY-NC](cc-by-nc)). The records of two organizations - CAMRA BC ([series 1](f-318-1)) and the Great Canadian Beer Festival Society ([series 2](f-318-2)) - are included in the fonds and they likely hold the copyright to many of those materials. The GCBF Society is a defunct organization; Rowling was a director, but it is not clear to whom their copyright now belongs. CAMRA BC continues as an active organization. The fonds also includes copyright-protected works created by third parties, especially in the artefacts ([series 5](f-318-5)) and books and magazines ([series 6](f-318-6)) Rowling collected. For these materials, the Archives may make copies available for private study or research purposes under the fair dealing provisions of Canada's Copyright Act. Use for any other purpose may require the permission of the copyright owner. SFU Archives can assist researchers in attempting to identify copyright owners, but it is the user's responsibility to contact owners and secure any required permissions or assume all risks arising from not so doing.

The hard-copy and the pdf versions of the finding aid include two appendices: a fuller list of CAMRA BC officers (Appendix A) and an index by brewery to the artefacts in [series 5](f-318-5) (Appendix B).

Scope and content:

Series consists of records made or received by John Rowling in his capacity as a member and officer of CAMRA BC. Rowling served as President of the Victoria branch from 1990-1992 and 2000-2003. The records mainly reflect the workings of the Victoria branch, but up to 2010 the Executive of CAMRA Victoria acted for BC as a whole.

Activities and events documented include the establishment of CAMRA BC; meetings, administration and management of membership; CAMRA public campaigns; and the production of the What's

Brewing newsletter. Series includes both paper and born-digital records. For record types, see sub-series descriptions.

During processing, the archivist used a script to batch-convert all files to create a set of pdf access copies and these are available alongside the originals. Researchers should be aware that not all file formats could convert to pdf by this method; and in some cases (e.g. Excel) conversion to pdf may result in loss or significant distortion of original document formatting and functionality.
