Women and Words/Les femmes et les mots was a national conference organized by the West Coast Women and Words Society and held in Vancouver from June 30 to July 3, 1983. Participants included Canadian women writers, editors, publishers, critics, printers, typesetters, academics, playwrights, librarians, distributors, booksellers, translators, and educational and cultural organizers. The conference featured presentations of papers, panel discussions, workshops and interviews relevant to such themes as: feminism, power and alternative structures doing it (i.e. developing work strategies), traditions and new directions. Following the conference, the West Coast Women and Word Society compiled and published in 1983 an anthology of previously unpublished prose, poetry, critical work and short one-act plays by Canadian women.
