Berthe de Trémaudan, nee Guspín, came to Canada in 1920. She is the author of three books, all written in French, including *Au Nord du 53e*, about her experiences in Northern Manitoba. de Trémaudan lived in British Columbia from 1943 until her death in 1996.

Note

Anne de Mishaegen was a hunter and adventurer who visited Canada in the 1930s. She is the author of *Trappeur Blanc* (1937) and *Dans la Forêt Canadienne* (1944).
