Advisory: SFU hosts international development competition and symposium to spur innovation and cooperation

SFU International, in partnership with the British Columbia Council for International Cooperation and the University of the Fraser Valley, will host a two-day symposium and DevLab—an international development project pitch competition with a prize of \$10,000 in project seed funds—from June 6-7, 2018 in downtown Vancouver.

The symposium will feature a keynote address by Canadian Ambassador to Algeria, Patricia McCullagh.
