## **Fonds description**

### **James Delgado Fonds. – MsC 123**

1964 – 2010.

4.357 m of textual records and other material.

**Biographical sketch:** James Preston (Jim) Delgado was born on January 11, 1958 in San Jose, California, USA. He showed an early interest in history and archaeology and, at age fourteen, joined his first dig after noticing human remains at a construction site. The graduate students from an archaeology class from San Jose State took Delgado under their wing as they worked on the project. Most of the finds were turned over to the university except the human remains Delgado had found, which were repatriated to their descendants and reburied. Delgado met with the mayor of San Jose to voice his concerns regarding the desecration of the past, and was appointed to the City of San Jose Historic Landmarks Commission. Throughout high school he joined local archaeologists in exploring sites, and also worked as a guide at the New Almaden Mining Museum.

Delgado studied history at San Jose State University and at San Francisco State University, where he earned his BA in 1981. While at San Francisco State, he worked with the United States National Park Service (NPS). His interest in maritime archaeology increased when he saw the wreck of the ship *Niantic*, which had been unearthed by construction in 1978. He served as Park Historian with the cultural resources management team at the Golden Gate National Recreation Area from 1979 to 1986. There he worked on documenting and preserving historic and archaeological sites, particularly ships and buildings along the buried waterfront of Gold Rush San Francisco.

From 1984 to 1985 Delgado studied at East Carolina University, where he earned an MA in Maritime History and Underwater Research. During this time, he also taught US history and surveyed Cape Hatteras National Seashore's beaches for shipwrecks. Next, he joined an NPS team as Project Historian working on the wreck of the ship *USS Monitor*.

From 1986 to 1991 Delgado served as the Maritime Historian for the NPS and the head of the Maritime Initiative, the US government's maritime preservation program in Washington, D.C. His work for the Maritime Initiative involved visiting and inventorying every known historic maritime resource, including lighthouses, shipwrecks, shipyards, and floating ships, and developing standards for their preservation and restoration. During his time with the NPS, he also surveyed and explored the wrecks of the *USS Arizona* and *USS Utah* at Pearl Harbour, the sunken fleet of atomic bombed warships at Bikini Atoll, and many other shipwrecks.

In 1991 Delgado was appointed Executive Director of the Vancouver Maritime Museum (VMM) in Vancouver, British Columbia. During his time at the VMM, the Museum organized a reenactment of the RCMP schooner *St. Roch's* voyage through the Northwest Passage and

circumnavigation of North America. Delgado also worked on the restoration of the Ben Franklin, a historic oceanographic research submersible.

From 2001 to 2006 Delgado co-hosted National Geographic's television series "The Sea Hunters" with Clive Cussler. He has also worked on television special for the Discovery Channel, National Geographic Explorer, the History Channel, A&E, and ABC.

In 2006, Delgado received his PhD in Archaeology from Simon Fraser University. His dissertation was entitled "Gold Rush Entrepôt: The Maritime Archaeology of the Rise of the Port of San Francisco." That year, he left the VMM to join the Institute of Nautical Archaeology (INA), and was elected President and Chief Executive Officer of the INA in 2008. Delgado's work for the INA involved public outreach, media relations, fundraising, membership, and project development. In October 2010, he left the INA to join the United States National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration as its Director of Maritime Heritage.

Delgado has written numerous articles and over thirty books, including "To California by Sea: A Maritime History of the California Gold Rush" (1990), "Ghost Fleet: The Sunken Ships of Bikini Atoll" (1996), "Adventures of a Sea Hunter: In Search of Famous Shipwrecks" (2004), "Waterfront: The Illustrated Maritime History of Greater Vancouver" (2005), "Khubilai Khan's Lost Fleet: History's Greatest Naval Disaster" (2009), and "Silent Killers: Submarines and Underwater Warfare" (2011). He served as editor for the book "Encyclopedia of Underwater and Maritime Archaeology" (1997).

Throughout his career, Delgado has led and participated in shipwreck expeditions around the world. These include explorations and dives of RMS Titanic, Carpathia, Mary Celeste, and Maud. He has also given many lectures and presentations regarding maritime archaeology.

Delgado and his first wife Mary had two children, John and Beth. As of 2010, he lived with his wife Ann in Washington, DC.

**Scope and content:** The fonds consists of records created and accumulated by Delgado since 1964 through his personal and professional activities. It contains correspondence, personal records, photographs, video recordings, and audio recordings. Records primarily focus on projects (shipwreck and historic sites), expeditions, lectures and education, and Delgado's writing. The fonds also focuses on Delgado's work with the National Park Service, the Vancouver Maritime Museum, and the Institute for Nautical Archaeology, and on his work on "The Sea Hunters" television program.

The fonds is divided into the following eleven series: Correspondence (1973-2012), Personal records (1964-2013), Project records (1967-2010), Expedition records (1995-2009), Sea Hunters records (1999-2006), Writing records ([197-]-2011), Newspaper clippings (1972-2008), Lectures and education records (1978-2008), Audio recordings (1977-[199-?]), Images (1969-[before 2010]), and Video recordings (1970-[before 2010]).

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the contents of the fonds.

**Physical description note:** Includes ca. 4000 photographs : b&w and col. ; prints, negatives, and slides, 41 postcards, 3 posters : col., 3 plaques, and 1 paper hat.

**Immediate source of acquisition note:** The fonds was acquired from James Delgado by the Simon Fraser University Library Special Collections and Rare Books in one accession in 2010.

**Arrangement note:** Series and sub-series have been created by the Archivist according to format (such as video recordings, images, audio recordings, and electronic records) or activity (such as project, expedition, and writing records). Within series and sub-series, all files have been arranged chronologically following the creator's original order, except where otherwise noted. Square brackets have been used in the file list to indicate titles and dates supplied by the Archivist.

For preservation reasons, photographs, audio cassettes, and videocassettes contained within files of textual records have been removed from their original files. See individual file notes for the physical locations of these materials.

**Language note:** All materials are in English except for one article in Norwegian.

**Restrictions on access, reproduction and publication note:** Records created or published prior to January 1, 2010 are available only for the purposes of research and private study during James

Delgado's lifetime. Access to records created or published after January 1, 2006 requires the written permission of James Delgado.

## Series Descriptions

### Correspondence series.

1973 – 2009.

1.95 m of textual records

49 photographs : b&w and col.; prints and slides

**Scope and content:** Series consists of incoming and outgoing correspondence created and received by James Delgado pertaining to personal and professional matters. Correspondence relates to Delgado's work with the San Jose Historical Landmarks Commission, the National Park Service, and the Vancouver Maritime Museum, as well as to his professional research interests and the publication of various books and articles. Records includes letters, cards, and email printouts, as well as attachments and related records such as newspaper clippings, certificates, articles, newsletters, lecture programs, and contracts.

The series has been arranged into the following three sub-series: Personal correspondence (1973-1989, 2001- 2009), Outgoing correspondence (1978-1991, 2004-2006), and Incoming correspondence (1990-2006).

### Personal correspondence sub-series.

1973 - 1989, 2001 - 2009.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of correspondence created or received by James Delgado, as well as other related records labelled "personal papers" and "personal correspondence" in the creator's original arrangement of his files. Correspondence from 1973 to 1989 focuses primarily on Delgado's time with the San Jose Historical Landmarks Commission and the National Park Service, and correspondence from 2001 to 2009 focuses on Delgado's time at the Vancouver Maritime Museum. Records include letters, email printouts, and cards, as well as attachments and related records such as photographs, certificates, newspaper clippings, newsletters, lecture programs, publication contracts, and writing drafts.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Outgoing correspondence sub-series.**

1978 - 1991, 2004 - 2006.

.37 m of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of James Delgado's outgoing correspondence. Correspondence from 1978 to 1991 focuses on Delgado's time as Historian for the National Park Service, Golden Gate National Recreation Area, and includes his responses for requests for information, reports on historic sites and shipwrecks authored by Delgado, and focuses on several specific projects he undertook during his time there. Correspondence from 2004 to 2010 primarily relates to the business of the Vancouver Maritime Museum.

**Incoming correspondence sub-series.**

1990 - 2006.

11 photographs : col.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of James Delgado's incoming correspondence, primarily relating to his professional activities. Records span Delgado's time working with the National Park Service, the National Maritime Initiative, the Vancouver Maritime Museum, and the Institute of Nautical Archaeology, and relate to administrative matters at these institutions, as well as events he attended and projects he worked on. Correspondence relating to shipwreck and historic site projects includes expedition reports, itineraries, and research records. Correspondence relating to Delgado's writing projects focuses on the publication of books and articles, and includes some copies of articles written by Delgado, advertisements for his books, and book reviews. Sub-series also contains some correspondence relating to the television program "The Sea Hunters." Records include letters, email and fax printouts, and greeting cards, as well as attachments and related records such as newsletters, certificates, newspaper clippings, and magazine articles.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

### **Personal records series.**

1964 – [2003?].

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records created or accumulated by James Delgado's through his early life and his personal activities. Records relate to his years as a student, his job applications, and his personal interests and achievements. Records include correspondence (including letters, printouts of emails, and greeting cards), drafts of Delgado's resume and job applications, certificates, awards, early writings, drawings, high school assignments, photographs, and newspaper clippings. Series also includes records documenting Delgado's appointment to the role of Executive Director of the Vancouver Maritime Museum (VMM), as well as brochures and newspaper clippings regarding the VMM and its exhibits.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the series.

**Physical description note:** Includes: 19 photographs : b&w and col., 3 plaques, and 1 paper hat.

### **Project records series.**

1967 – 2009.

135 photographs : b&w and col.; prints, slides, and negatives

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to projects James Delgado worked on for the National Park Service, the Vancouver Maritime Museum, and the Institute of Nautical Archaeology. Records focus on archaeological and shipwreck sites, court cases regarding salvage and treasure hunting of shipwrecks, and nominations of archaeological and shipwreck sites for Historic Places status. Records include correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings, articles, reports, surveys, and proposals. The series has been divided into the following three sub-series: General project records (1967-2007), Maritime archaeology records (1973-1991), and S.S. Central America records (1978-1994).

### **General records sub-series.**

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of records relating to various projects James Delgado worked on throughout his professional career. Records were created or compiled by Delgado through his work for the National Park Service, the Vancouver Maritime Museum, and the Institute of Nautical Archaeology. A large number of files are related to exploring shipwreck sites, court cases related to shipwreck salvage, and the nomination of shipwrecks for Historic Places status. Records include correspondence, photographs, notes, meeting agendas and minutes, newspaper clippings, journal and magazine articles, pamphlets, trip reports and itineraries, press releases, project proposals, and reports.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

#### **Maritime archaeology records sub-series.**

1973 – 1991.

.18 m of textual records

117 photographs : b&w and col. ; prints, slides, and negatives

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of records created or compiled by James Delgado through his work on maritime archaeology projects, primarily projects undertaken while he worked as a historian for the National Park Service. A large number of records focus on Delgado's work on the preservation of shipwreck sites through the National Registry of Historic Places. Records include correspondence, newspaper clippings, slides and photographs, research records, and surveys of shipwrecks.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

#### **S.S. Central America records sub-series.**

1978 – 1994.

.33 m of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists records relating to the sinking of the ship S.S. Central America in 1857, as well as records relating to the ship's salvage and the resulting

court case regarding ownership of its treasure, for which Delgado served as an expert witness. Records include newspaper articles, research records, and legal documents.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Related groups of records note:** For files related to an article Delgado wrote about the *S.S. Central America* song, see also files 37.1 and 37.2 in the Writing series, Published Articles sub-series.

### **Expedition records series.**

1995 – 2009.

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to archaeological tourist expeditions, boat cruises and exploratory expeditions of shipwrecks, for which James Delgado served as a lecturer or expedition leader. Records include correspondence, brochures, reports, pamphlets, travel itineraries, and expedition reports.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the series.

### **Sea hunters records series.**

1999 – 2006.

.22 m of textual records and other material

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to the production of the National Geographic television show "The Sea Hunters," which James Delgado co-hosted with Clive Cussler from 2001 to 2006. Series contains correspondence and administrative records relating to the show, research records, photographs, and video recordings of episodes. Series is arranged into the following four sub-series: Episode files (1999-2006), Photographs (2000-2005), Slides (2001-2004), and Video recordings (1999-2005).

**Physical description note:** Includes: ca. 1000 photographs : b&w and col. ; prints, negatives, and slides, 41 postcards, and 36 videocassettes.

**Episode files sub-series.**

1999 – 2006.

41 postcards.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains incoming and outgoing correspondence between James Delgado, Eco-Nova Multimedia Productions, and others involved with the production of 'The Sea Hunters' television series. Also included are newspaper clippings and articles written by Delgado regarding episodes or their subject matter, research records, records relating to and ideas for episodes, and travel and filming itineraries.

**Photographs sub-series.**

2000 – 2005.

ca. 700 photographs : col. ; prints and negatives

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains photographs, contact sheets, and negatives compiled by James Delgado relating to the television series "The Sea Hunters." Photographs depict Delgado and the "Sea Hunters" team members during the planning, research, and filming of episodes.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Slides sub-series.**

2001 – 2004.

361 slides : col.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains slides compiled by James Delgado during the filming of "The Sea Hunters." Slides relate to several locations, shipwrecks, and events featured in the series, including Vrouw Maria (Finland), Fox (Greenland), USS Akron, Dresden (Chile), and D-day.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Video recordings sub-series.**

1999 – 2005.

36 videocassettes

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains videocassettes of episodes of "The Sea Hunters," including the final cuts of episodes intended for broadcast, master tapes, and clips, as well as videocassettes for press kits.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Writing records series.**

[197-] – 2009.

.68 m of textual records

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to the writing and editing activities of James Delgado throughout his professional career. It includes correspondence with publishers, editors, co-authors, and other stakeholders regarding the publication of books and articles, reports written for university assignments and for his employers, writings drafts, articles, book covers, and research records. Series also includes publicity records and reviews of Delgado's books.

The series has been arranged into six sub-series: Books and publication records ([197-]-2009), Reports (1977-1992), Correspondence (1980-2008), Article drafts ([before 1990?]-2001), Published articles (1979-2004), and Publicity records and reviews (1991-2006).

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the series.

**Physical description note:** Series contains: 5 colour photographs, 3 black and white photographs, and 1 black and white negative.

**Books and publication records sub-series.**

[197-] – 2009.

7 photographs : b&w and col.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of records relating to Delgado's activities writing and books, pamphlets, and booklets. Series contains drafts and covers of books, as well some pamphlets and booklets. Also included are research records and correspondence regarding the publication of his books.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

### **Reports sub-series.**

1977 – 1992.

7.9 cm of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains reports written or co-authored by Delgado, primarily for university assignments and for the National Park Service. Also included are assessments of historical sites and other surveys and reports focusing on historical, archaeological or shipwreck sites.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

### **Correspondence sub-series.**

1980 – 2008.

2.8 cm of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains correspondence relating to Delgado's writing activities, including the publication of books and articles. Also contains some correspondence relating to projects Delgado participated in, such as the Sutro Heights Park and USS Mississinewa projects.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

### **Article drafts sub-series.**

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains several unpublished drafts of articles written by Delgado relating to historical events such as the Cuban Missile Crisis and the September 11, 2001 attack.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Published articles sub-series.**

1979 – 2004.

.2 m of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains articles written by Delgado which were published in magazines, newspapers, scholarly journals, newsletters, etc. They focus on his work for the National Park Service, his earlier Archaeological work/interests, San Francisco history, and examine specific shipwrecks.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Publicity records and reviews sub-series.**

1991 – 2006.

6 cm of textual records

**Scope and content:** Sub-series contains newspaper clippings, printouts, and reviews from newsletters and journals of books written by Delgado. Also included are publishers' publicity/promotional material for his books and some correspondence from publishers with attached reviews of his books. The Book Reviews files contain reviews written by Delgado of other author's books.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Newspaper clippings series.**

1972 – 2007.

3 photographs : b&w.

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to newspaper articles written by James Delgado, featuring Delgado, or citing him or his work. These articles relate primarily to his early work on archaeological digs, his writing, expeditions he has participated in, and to shipwreck discoveries. Records include email printouts and newspaper clippings (both originals and photocopied reproductions).

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the series.

### **Lectures and education records series.**

1978 – 2008.

**Scope and content:** Series consists of records relating to James Delgado's speaking engagements, teaching activities, and other events he has attended. Records include correspondence, publicity records (including posters, brochures, and leaflets), itineraries, and conference proceedings, programs and papers.

**Related groups of records note:** See also the Project series, General Projects sub-series file 19.12 “The Storm Unleashed – Pearl Harbor 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Symposium” for more lecture related documents.

### **Audio recordings series.**

**Scope and content:** Series consists of audio cassettes, primarily of interviews with James Delgado or of interviews conducted by him. Some tapes relate to shipwreck dives and other projects he has worked on.

ca. 3000 photographs : b&w and col. ; prints, slides, and negatives

**Scope and content:** Series contains photographs, (including prints, contact sheets, negatives and slides) created or compiled by James Delgado relating to his professional and personal activities. Images relate to his archaeological and maritime work, writing, and his personal life. The series has been divided into three sub-series: Photographs (1975-2008), Titanic images ([2000?]), and Slides (1969-[before 2010]).

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the series.

**Photographs sub-series.**

1975 – 2008.

ca. 300 photographs : b&w and col. ; prints and negatives

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of photographs relating to various expeditions, trips, and projects, created or compiled by James Delgado throughout his professional career. Photographs depict shipwrecks, dives, exhibits, and events at the Vancouver Maritime Museum. Records included print photographs, contact sheets, and negatives.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Physical description note:** Sub-series contains: 191 colour photographs, 12 black and white photographs, 9 black and white contact sheets and 12 sleeves of black and white negatives.

**Titanic images sub-series.**

ca. 150 photographs : col.

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of a print of a drawing of the Titanic, as well as colour photographs, printed from digital images onto non-photographic paper, of underwater images from the Titanic and artefacts recovered from the Titanic.

**Source of title proper:** Title based on the content of the sub-series.

**Related groups of records note:** For more documents related to these images of Titanic artefacts, see also file 21.10 JPD: Titanic Arch. Review in the Projects series, General Projects sub-series.

### **Slides sub-series.**

**Scope and content:** Sub-series consists of photographic slides created or compiled by James Delgado through his professional and personal activities. Includes slides compiled by Delgado for research, writing, and other professional activities, as well as slides created from personal family photographs.
