#### FONDS DESCRIPTION

Jackson, Robert, 1914-2000. Robert Jackson fonds. - 1933-2000. 90 cm textual records and other material.

#### **Biographical Sketch:**

Robert "Bob" Jackson was born March 18, 1914 in Vancouver, British Columbia. The first of four children, he left his parent's home at age 13 to work. In the 1930s Jackson helped organize men in government-run labour camps for the On to Ottawa Trek of 1935. Jackson and Agnes "Aggie" Martin married in December 1938 and the couple had three children: Roberta Carol (born 1939), Kenneth William (born 1942), and Larry Steven (born 1948). Jackson served in the Canadian Navy during the World War Two and worked for decades in wood mills in Vancouver. He was a member of the Communist Party and of the Industrial Wood and Allied Workers of Canada until he supported a failed attempt to split that union in 1948. Jackson and his wife enjoyed travel after their children were grown, journeying to Europe, the U.S.S.R., and Cuba, hi 1972 Agnes Jackson was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease and Bob Jackson cared for her in their home, which was by then located in Powell River, B.C., for many years. Jackson devoted much of his time later in life to educating younger Canadians about labour history based on his first-hand experiences. Jackson was a socialist and an advocate of workers' rights and he supported these causes until his death from cancer June 27, 2000, just two months after his wife's passing.

### **Scope and Content:**

Fonds consists primarily of records related to Robert Jackson's political interests and activities. The fonds includes many original and reproduction documents from labour events in the 1930s, particularly the On to Ottawa trek but including information on other labour related events and figures, including the Spanish Civil War and the unionism in primary resource industries. The fonds also includes many records gathered by Jackson in the 1980s and 1990s in his work commemorating the On to Ottawa trek and participating in labour related events. The fonds contains newsletters, bulletins and other publications, newspaper clippings, essays, and articles, correspondence, recollections and testimonials, obituaries, notes from speaking engagements, leaflets, posters, press releases, petitions, minutes, financial records, project proposals, a script, work documents, certificates, legal documents, photographs, and other records related to Jackson's political life. The file level arrangement of this fonds is based on an arrangement established in 2001 by David Yorke who undertook to order Jackson's paper by subject. The order in which Jackson kept his records is unknown. The fonds is arranged in four series: On to Ottawa Trek (1934-2000); Labour history subject files (1933-2000); Memorials (1985-2000); and Photographs ([193-?]-2000).

#### SERIES/SUB-SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

#### On to Ottawa Trek

1934-2000.

35 cm textual records and other material.

Series consists of reproductions of newsletters and newspaper clippings contemporary to the On to Ottawa Trek, and records from the 1980s and 1990s related to the original Trek and Jackson's participation in its commemoration in various incarnations. Records consist of correspondence, recollections and testimonials, obituaries, Jackson's notes from speaking engagements, essays and articles. The series includes two sub-series: On to Ottawa Trek Committee (1938; 1985; 1996); On to Ottawa Historical Committee (1986-1999).

Sub-series consists of correspondence, notes, lists, sign-in sheets, press releases, leaflets, posters, newspaper items, petitions, proclamations, and other records generated in the course of the work of this Committee dedicated to commemorating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the On to Ottawa Trek.

### On to Ottawa Historical Society

Sub-series consists of minutes, correspondence, financial records, newspaper articles, a script, a project proposal, and other records related to the activities and projects of the On to Ottawa Historical Society including the production of a video documentary about the On to Ottawa Trek.

### Labour history subject files

Series consists of newspaper clippings, typescripts, articles, and essays, correspondence, photographs, and other records related to historical events and figures. These records reflect Jackson's activities as a union member and supporter, as a member of the Communist Party of Canada, and as a supporter of the Spanish Civil War and other left wing political causes.

#### **International Woodworkers of America**

Series consists of articles and essays, work documents, certificates, correspondence, newsletters, clippings, legal documents, and other records related

to forestry and woodworkers, Jackson's membership in the IWA union, and his participation in the splinter Woodworkers Industrial Union of Canada. Title based on contents of sub-series.

#### Memorials

1985-2000.

2 cm textual records.

Series consists two files, one containing memorials and tributes to friends of Robert and Agnes Jackson and participants in the On to Ottawa Trek, the other containing memorials and tributes to Robert and Agnes Jackson upon their deaths.

### **Photographs**

[193-?]-2000.

15 cm of photographs.

Series consists of photographic images of labour conditions and political activities during the 1930s, and photographs of commemorations of the On to Ottawa trek, as well as a slide presentation with an accompanying script.
